

Impressed with what he saw on his maiden voyage to the North American Continent, French Explorer Jacques Cartier ventured further down the St. Lawrence River to present day Quebec City and Montreal known as Stadacona and Hochledga respectively by the Iroquois.

Intrigued by the natural beauty of what is now kown as Province of Quebec, Samuel de Champlain forged the foundation of a permanent settlement in Quebed City in 1608. Over 400 years later, the legacy of the Fathers of Quebec remains as a unique and vibrant French Speaking society surrounded by English Canada and the United States.


Although the French colony was lost to the British in 1763, Quebec emerged as an important partner in the establishment of an independent Canada and remains a significant part of our multi-cultrual country.
