

Known as *Stadacona* by the *Iroquois*, French Explorer *Jacques Cartier* was impressed with the strategic location of what became known as *Quebec City*. Venturing further down the river to *Hochledga* which would emerge as *Montreal*, the French built settlements which ultimately became known as *New France*.

Intrigued by the natural beauty of what is now known as the *Province of Quebec*, *Samuel de Champlain* forged the foundation of a permanent settlement in *Quebec City* in 1608. Over 400 years later, the legacy of the *Fathers of Quebec* remains as a unique and vibrant French Speaking society surrounded by *English Canada* and the *United States*.

Although, the French colony was lost to the British in 1763, *Quebec* emerged as an important partner in the establishment of an independent *Canada* and remains a significant part of our multi-cultural county.

We invite your group to join us in 2026 to explore *Quebec* just like *Cartier* and *Champlain* to discover remnants of a bygone era.


